Grandson of New Chinatown Founder Peter SooHoo Sr. and son of Peter Jr. and Lucy SooHoo, Jon SooHoo is in his 24th season as the official team photographer for the Los Angeles Dodgers.

SooHoo has been part of the Los Angeles sports scene since 1982, shooting most local major sporting events including the Lakers, Clippers, Kings, Rams, Raiders, USC,

UCLA, Dodgers and Angels, as well as races at the Auto Club Speedway as the contract photographer. SooHoo has covered World Series, Super Bowls, Bowl Championship Series Games, All-Star Games, Pro Bowls, the Daytona 500 and his favorite non-sporting event: the Space Shuttle launch from Cape Canaveral in Florida.



As the team photographer for the Los Angeles Dodgers, SooHoo spends approximately two-thirds of each year embedded with the “Boys in Blue” — whether at Spring Training, on the road with the team or covering home games at Dodger Stadium. His images have helped preserve team history since 1985. He has been the most recent addition to PeteCarroll.com as official team photographer, shooting behind the scenes of USC football games for head football coach Pete Carroll’s website.
